Target Audience:

Goal:

It is the goal of this educational activity to assist professionals who provide care to older adults to understand the issues of substance abuse and medication abuse and misuse, to provide assessment and interventions, and to advocate for age specific treatment.

Educational Objectives:

1. Articulate current and projected incidence and prevalence rates of older adults with substance and medication abuse/misuse issues – baby boomers vs. current
2. Describe why the issues of substance and medication abuse/ misuse in older adults are hidden and complex problems.
3. Identify substance and medication abuse/misuse prevention, screening, intervention and treatment models with integrated approaches that work with older adults.
